

# Download 6th Grade Experimental Probability Test Practice

Some of the worksheets displayed are Science 7th grade stats probability crossword 2 name, 7 th statistics probability, Science 7th grade stats probability crossword 1 name, 6th grade lesson plan probably probability, Experimental probability work show your work, Probability work 1, Grade 7 math practice test, Incoming 7th grade summer math ...Note that the theoretical probability of rolling a 4 is  $\frac{1}{6}$  (1 favorable outcome) / (6 possible outcomes), but the experimental probability may be different from  $\frac{1}{6}$ . For example, if a student tosses the number cube 6 times and fails to toss a 4, the experimental probability will be  $\frac{0}{6}$ , or 0.
