

Download Hospital Healthcare Facility Operation Maintenance

In 1997 OSHA estimated that more than 5.3 million workers in more than 100,000 hospitals, homeless shelters, long-term care facilities for the elderly, detention facilities, certain laboratories and other work settings have a high risk of TB infection. Policies and Program Administration (Company name) maintains, reviews and updates the Exposure Control Plan (ECP) at least annually, and whenever necessary to reflect new or modified tasks, procedures and engineering controls * that affect occupational exposure.
