

Download How To Make The 4 Flute Wall Rack For Native American Flutes

This is a gorgeous flute wall rack. I own a cedar Native American flute and wasn't sure how to display it. This is a beautifully put together rack that suits my flute very well. I am very happy with my purchase. You can get the wood and hardware for this wall rack at Lowes or home depot. You can get the sticky back felt to protect the flutes at Michaels craft store or hobby lobby. Sand all wood with sanding paper about 180 grit, or use foam sanding block. Make a template of the sides on thin plywood, and use it to trace onto the wood sides. Stackable Flute Rack – Description. The racks are made from fir. They come in 2 different sizes.... Small and Large. The small rack is for small and medium sized flutes and holds up to 10 flutes and the large rack is for the bass and drone sized flutes and holds up to 9 flutes. These racks are being offered in 2 different shades....make your flute prone to cracking. Also, sometimes the sound can be affected by the wall thickness, so try to stay around 3/16". Step 4: Fundamental Note – Well here is where the “rubber meets the road”. Time to blow through it and see what voice it has.
