Section 5106 of the SBIR/STTR Reauthorization Act of 2011 authorized that NIH may 'issue a Phase II award to a small business concern that did not receive a Phase I award for that research/research & development'. The NIH SBIR program funds early stage small businesses that are seeking to commercialize innovative biomedical technologies. This competitive program helps small businesses participate in federal research and development, develop life-saving technologies, and create jobs.
