

# Download Occupational Therapy Soap Note Examples

The basic outline of a therapy note should follow the SOAP format: Subjective, Objective, Assessment, and Plan. Both occupational therapy and physical therapy soap notes should have the same basic format whether you are writing an evaluation, a daily note, a progress note or a discharge note. I have been an occupational therapist for more than 30 years. ROUTINE SOAP NOTE EXAMPLES S: "I feel like I can't empty my bladder." O: Patient is febrile at 100.4 with pain in low back 4/10. A: Patient has symptoms consistent with UTI with increased complaints of pain and low grade fever requiring addressing, managing, and monitoring of symptoms. As part of occupational therapy, you will write SOAP notes to document the progress of your patients. SOAP is an acronym for subjective, objective, assessment and plan. Interview your patient at the beginning of your therapy session and document her subjective state.
