Guided Practice Teacher and students will create a tone and mood words anchor chart for the class. The anchor chart will consist of a list of words that describe the author's tone and mood. Students will now have a set of 24 cards. On the first 12 cards, students will write mood words, and on the second set of cards students will write tone words. Here's how it works: Select four events for students to tell how they felt when the event occurred. Students will think of three mood words for each event and write one on each card. Tone is the narrator's attitude toward his or her subject. It is like tone of voice in that people use the same words to describe them. For example, one could say that the narrator's tone is sarcastic if that narrator were mocking the characters.
